13. Modern Dolls under 18" (45cm.)
14. Large Modern Dolls 18"-31" (45 -78 cm)
15. Modern Dolls in Dimensional Doll Painting (DDP) with Painted Eyes (all types). Must have painted upper and lower lashes. No Glue-on lashes. Porcelain hands are desirable.

All-bisque body allowed up to 20”

Maximum height is 31”

Must bring a worksheet of doll [antique categories] with each entry, or close-up picture.
